Background on the film TRAVIS



One of the most significant UFO events in history -- Travis Walton's 1975 experience comes alive in this documentary of one man's trauma and transition after a mysterious beam of light strikes him unconscious. The 21 year-old logger from Snowflake Arizona disappeared for five days, igniting a firestorm of controversy aimed at

the logging crew who were the last to see him in the forest.

TRAVIS combines new and archived interviews with the logging crew, police, and the polygraph examiner. Walton explains how this event changed his life forever, as the media, skeptics, and debunkers attacked him and his friends and family. UFO - experts explain why this story continues to astound investigators, researchers, astrophysicists, journalist, and filmmakers in their quest for reliable evidence of other worlds, other beings, and more advanced technologies.

The experiences Travis and the other men have were well documented with reliable polygraph experts, police, family members, psychologist, and UFO researchers at the time. Travis's story remains one of the most intriguing and best-documented UFO encounters of all time. Paramount Pictures 1993 release of "Fire in the Sky" fictionalized the events into a dramatic re-enactment but left Travis and others wishing more truth to be known about this event. Travis published his own book, "Fire in the Sky" in 1995. The film "**Travis - The True Story of Travis Walton**" reveals the details of the event and the aftermath and fallout that naturally occurs including vicious debunking, ridicule, and sarcasm that has plagued this logging crew all their lives.

Background on this film project:

Jennifer did not start out make a documentary film about Travis, instead she started planning a 40th anniversary conference that would include a trip to the UFO event location in the woods outside of Heber Arizona. Author Peter Robbins invited Stein to meet Travis and to begin conference coordination meetings online. The actual UFO event location is remote and difficult to get to, so as a back up plan in case bad weather prevented a site tour for 20 to 40 people. Jennifer suggested creating a virtual site tour. This project is called Tracking SkyFire, and was spearheaded by Jennifer with co producer Bob Terrio. One thing led to another and before they knew it they were in Arizona shooting at forest site tour with Travis Walton for this new film.

Jennifer was closely involved with the planning of the 2014 MUFON symposium in Philadelphia when the sight tour was being edited, and Jennifer could see how she could take advantage of the existing footage, and fold into the film expert UFO-logists understanding of the significance of TRAVIS's event for viewers. Additional interviews were conducting with officials involved with the story at the time, and this turned into the fabulous new TRAVIS Documentary we have today. It was a lot of hard work and three years full time in the making. Travis was wiling to work closely with Jennifer, and she was honored to help bring his story to light.

This film is undergoing some re-editing for a commercially viable production for network television., and art house screenings. Travis story is an important one to be told, say's Jennifer, who had her own UFO event in 1975, and knows first hand how difficult these experiences can be to put into perspective.
